ORDINANCE NO: 134-98

AN ORDINANCE SETTING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN STREETS AND ROADWAYS IN THE BOROUGH OF BRIAR CREEK.

WHEREAS, 75 Pa. C.S.A. Section 3362 and 75 Pa. C.S.A. Section 6109 empowers local authorities to regulate the maximum permitted speed of vehicles on local roads within the boundaries of the local authority; and

WHEREAS, the increased traffic on local roads, and the increased rate of accidents and near accidents, pose a threat to the safety and public welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Briar Creek has conducted the traffic studies required by the rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Borough of Briar Creek hereby enacts and ordains the following maximum speed limits on the specified portions of the streets named herein:

- 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of the street where a maximum speed limit applies at higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street.
- 3. Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be fined the statutory fine as established by the Pennsylvania Legislature.
- 4. This Ordinance shall supersede any and all prior ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance, and all such prior ordinances or parts thereof are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.
- 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its lawful enactment.
