ORDINANCE NO. 135-98

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND PERMITTING EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC AND/OR PARKING REGULATIONS TO ALLOW FOR THE DETERMINATION OF THE FEASIBILITY AND DESIREABILITY OF PERMANENT CHANGES IN THE TRAFFIC AND/OR PARKING ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BRIAR CREEK.

WHEREAS, 75 Pa. C S A. Sections 3353, 3362 and 6109 authorize local authorities to regulate traffic and parking within the jurisdictional limits of the local authority; and

WHEREAS, studies and tests are required to determine the feasibility and desirability of proposed ordinance regulating traffic and/or parking within the jurisdictional limits of the Borough of Briar Creek; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Briar Creek has decided that the feasibility and desirability of proposed traffic and/or parking ordinances can best be determined by the temporary designation of locations where specific traffic and/or parking regulation, prohibitions and restrictions shall be in force and effect.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Borough of Briar Creek hereby ordains and enacts the following:

1. The Borough Council may from time to time designate places upon and along the highways in the Borough where for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, specific traffic and/or parking regulations, prohibitions and restrictions shall be in force and effect, and shall designate such locations by proper signs and markings. Such regulations, prohibitions and restrictions shall be effective just as if they had been contained in an ordinance.
2. No person shall operate or park a vehicle or tractor in violation of any such regulation, prohibition or restriction, and no person shall move, remove, destroy or deface any sign or marking erected, posted or made by authority of this section.
3. Any person who shall violate any provision of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable for a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) together with costs of prosecution.


4. This Ordinance shall supersede any and all prior ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance, and all such prior ordinances or parts thereof are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.


5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its lawful enactment.
